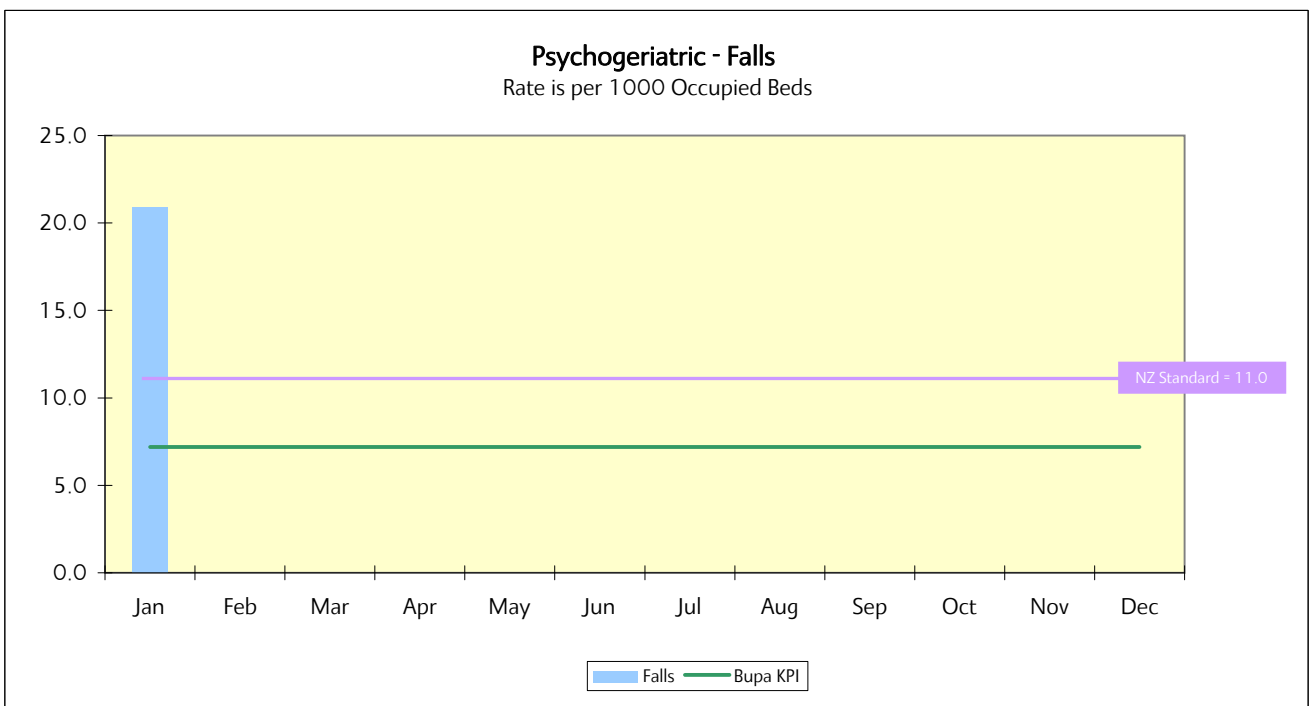




Psychogeriatric

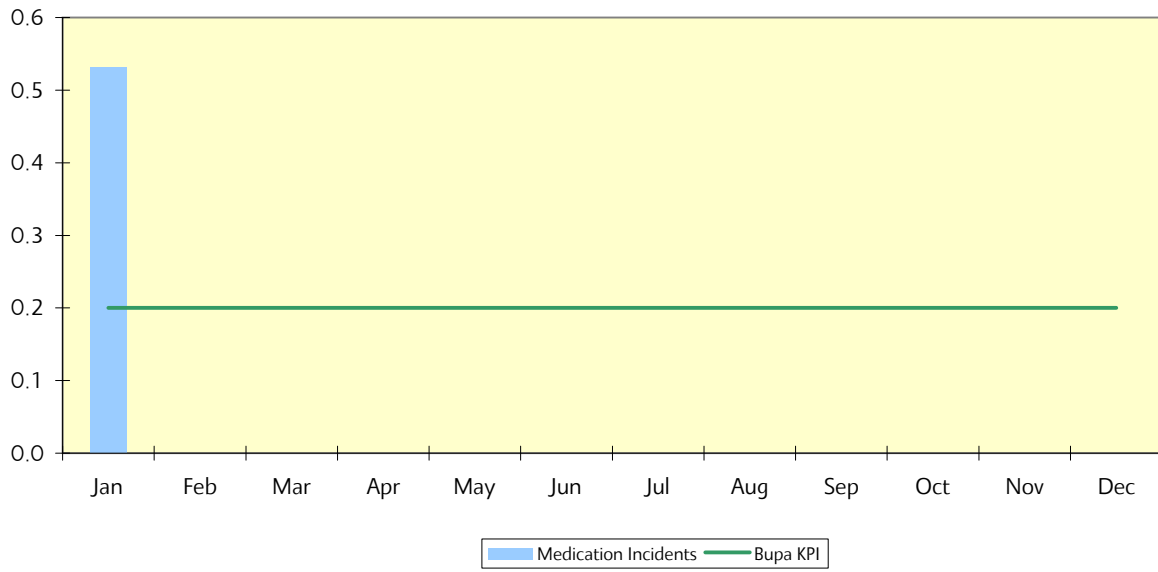
The graphs below show our monthly measures (for 9 Bupa psychogeriatric units combined) against key clinical indicators. For some measures, there is a target New Zealand standard - created by Standards NZ, endorsed by Ministry of Health (in purple). There is currently no data collected across all NZ rest homes for these incidents, so we can't provide an actual comparison.

For all standards, there is a Bupa target (green), which represents our desired improvement - because we always wish to improve our great care.



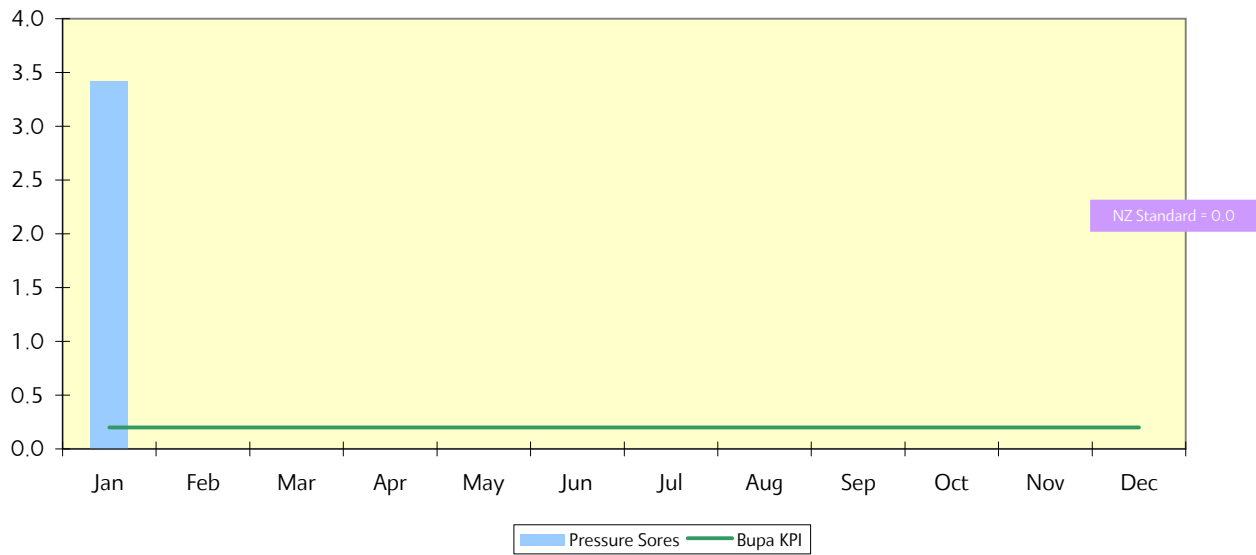
Psychogeriatric - Medication Incidents

Rate is per 1000 Occupied Beds



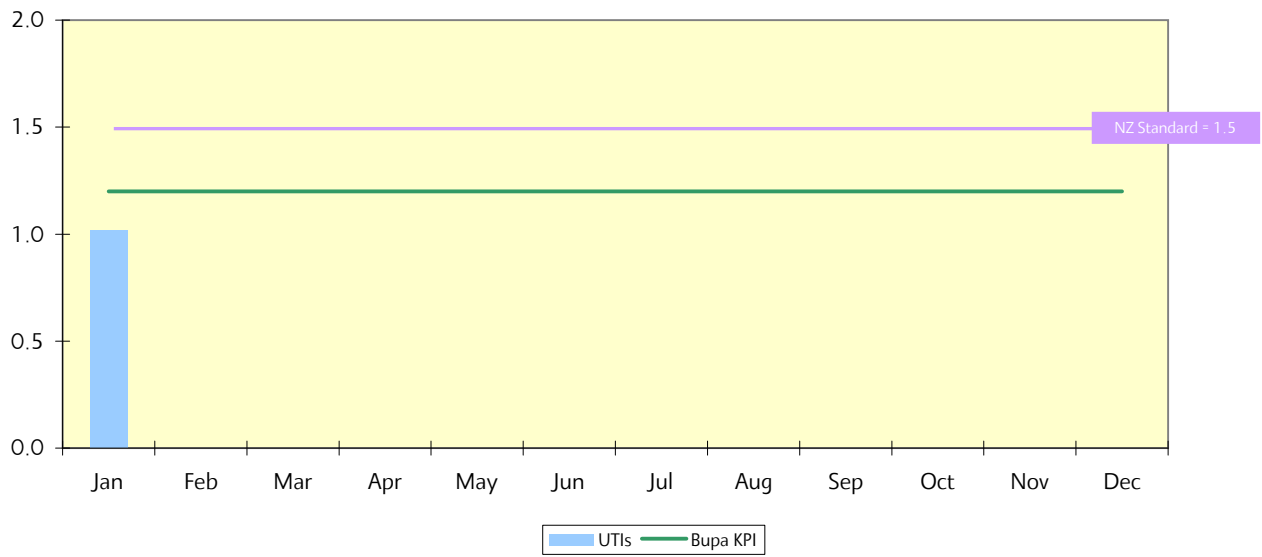
Psychogeriatric - Pressure Sores

Rate is per 1000 Occupied Beds



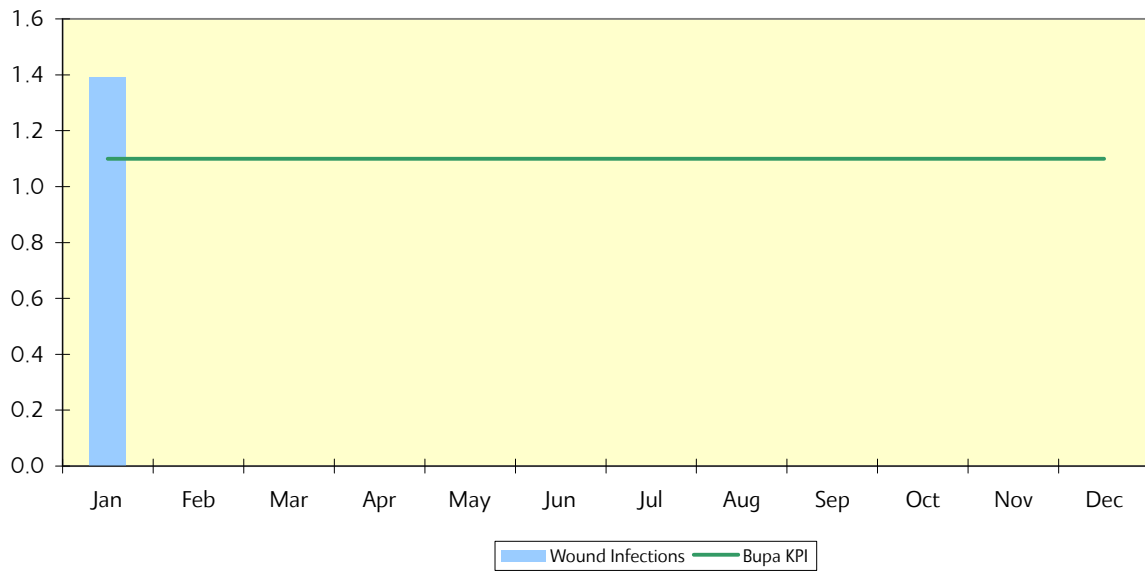
Psychogeriatric - Urinary Tract Infections
