Weekly fee

Residents pay a village weekly fee, monthly in advance, which is calculated as a proportion of the cost of the village outgoings, including but not limited to:

- Land rates
- Insurance (excluding your own personal belongings)
- Administration and management of the village
- Provision of all utilities, cleaning and servicing of communal areas
- Provision of domestic rubbish removal service
- Exterior maintenance of villas
- Maintenance of village facilities, lawns, gardens, roadways, paths and all common areas
- Provision for long term maintenance
- Exterior window cleaning at least twice a year
- Security patrols
- · Weekly transport for shopping

Additional services

The following additional services are available to you at an extra cost, if required:

- Provision of meals
- Laundry services
- Household cleaning

Community facilities

Community lounge

Library

A fully equipped kitchen is located in the community lounge.

Wellness clinic

Bupa offers health monitoring and professional advice by a Registered Nurse on a regular basis at the Wellness Clinic. This is available to all residents for no additional charge.

Bupa provides transportation for weekly outings or supermarket shopping trips. Other outings may attract a small charge.

Frequently asked questions

Can my friends and family stay with me?

It is your home, so you are welcome to have visitors stay for up to three weeks at a time. If your guests intend on staying longer, you will be required to get consent from the village manager.

Who will look after the lawn and gardens?

Bupa will take care of the general grounds within the village, and you are welcome to look after the garden surrounding your home if you wish. We can also take care of these gardens if you would prefer.

Can I access respite care?

Every year you stay in our retirement village, you will be entitled to seven days complimentary respite care in one of our care homes (subject to availability). To find out more about the eligibility requirements and T&Cs, please contact us.

Am I allowed to have pets?

Most small pets are welcome, however you will need to check with the village manager before you move in.

What if I want to go on holiday?

One of the benefits of living in a village is being able to lock up and go on holiday, safe in the knowledge that your home is being looked after.

What happens when I leave the village?

Bupa will market your villa and on re-licensing, Bupa will refund the money you paid, minus the amenities fee and any other amounts owing. In addition, if a new occupant cannot be found for your apartment within six months of your licence termination, you will be refunded as outlined above.
